

RESOLUTION 2013 – 12

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UMATILLA PROVIDING FOR SUPPORT OF THE ADDITION OF SEGMENTS OF STATE ROAD 19 LOCATED WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF UMATILLA, TO THE EXISTING STATE OF FLORIDA DESIGNATED CORRIDOR OF THE FLORIDA BLACK BEAR SCENIC BYWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 335.093, FLORIDA STATUTES, AND RULE 14-15.016, FLORIDA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE; RECOGNIZING THAT A CORRIDOR MANAGEMENT PLAN WILL BE FORTHCOMING FOR CONSIDERATION; AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO PARTICIPATE IN SUPPORTING EFFORTS TO DESIGNATE AND IMPLEMENT DESIGNATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a Corridor Management Entity known as the Florida Black Bear Scenic Byway, CME, has been formed for the purpose of implementing and maintaining the Corridor Management Plan for the existing State of Florida Designated Florida Black Bear Scenic Byway, as provided by Section 335.093, Florida Statutes, for the designation and implementation of a Florida Scenic Highway; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Black Bear Scenic Byway, CME, advocates that the Florida Black Bear Scenic Byway be located within a specified area of the City of Umatilla; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the scenic highway designation is to preserve, maintain, protect and enhance Florida's outstanding cultural, historical, archeological, recreational, natural and scenic resources, while utilizing these resources for appropriate economic development, recreation, and tourism; and


WHEREAS, significant benefits of economic development, recreational amenities, resource conservation, aesthetic enhancement and public education can result from the scenic highway designation; and

WHEREAS, a Corridor Management Plan that will delineate the goals and objectives of the scenic highway program to be developed and implemented with the participating local governments, without state or federal restrictions on land use within the corridor by virtue of the designation will be brought forward at a later date for consideration of the City Commission; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Umatilla, Florida that:


1. The City Council of the City of Umatilla supports the designation of the Florida Black Bear Scenic Byway as a Florida Scenic Highway. The Florida Black Bear Scenic Byway is proposed to be extended south on State Road 19 from its existing terminus at the Pittman Work Center to the southern limits of the City of Umatilla on State Road 19.
2. Upon presentation and approval of a Corridor Management Plan, the City Council will consider incorporating into the City of Umatilla Comprehensive Growth Plan a map displaying the Florida Black Bear Scenic Byway, the Corridor Vision Statement, and the appropriate Goals, Objectives and Strategies.
3. A copy of this resolution shall be incorporated into the minutes and official records of the City of Umatilla, and sent to the Florida Department of Transportation, the Board of County Commissioners of Lake County, the Board of County Commissioners of Marion County, the Board of County Commissioners of Volusia County, the Board of County Commissioners of Putnam County, The Cities of Ormond Beach, Ocala/Silver Springs and Palatka.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council of the City of Umatilla, Lake County, Florida, this 21st day of May, 2013.


